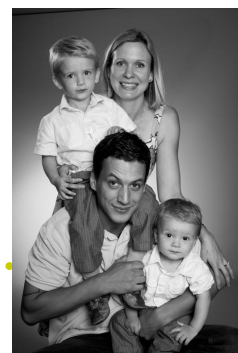
St. Andrew's URC, Bridle Road
